

Research Grant

Regulations regarding the award of research grant

- Maximum allocation - Rs. 300,000/- per year
- The principle investigator should be a member of the College of Ophthalmologists of Sri Lanka
- Innovative **prospective** research will be given priority when selections are made.
- Research proposals with ethical clearance can be considered for the research grant
- The Research Sub-committee of the COSL will assess the applications and make the recommendations to the college council for approval.
- Approved **prospective research proposals** will be awarded Rs. 10,000/- to initiate/ continue the projects
- The presentation of the research in a scientific congress as **a free paper** will qualify the research for a further Rs. 20,000/-.
- Poster presentations do not qualify.
- Publication in an indexed journal will qualify the research for a further Rs. 40,000/-
- These cash awards will be considered by the Research Sub-Committee of the COSL and will have to be approved by the council of the COSL
